THPRD Recreation Center Pool at 158th & Walker in Beaverton

The University of Oregon and Tualatin Hills Swim Club are proud to host the premier swimming conference championship. Five of the PAC-10 teams finished in the top nine teams at the 1984 NCAA Championships.

Competitors will include numerous U.S. and foreign athletes who were Olympic team members and medalists at the 1984 L.A. Games. These athletes include American Record Holders George DiCarlo of Arizona and Pablo Morales of Stanford.

There will be a special treat for swimmer/spectators. SPEEDO and TUALATIN HILLS SWIM CLUB are sponsoring a clinic for swimmers with PETER DALAND (USC coach) and DEBBIE MEYER REYES as speakers. Peter has led USC to 9 NCAA titles and was Head Coach of the 1964 and 1972 Olympic womens and mens teams. Debbie won 3 gold medals at the 1968 Olympics in Mexico City. The clinic will be held in the pool directly after the completion of Saturday preliminaries on March 9.

Due to limited seating capacity at the Recreation Center we expect the meet to be sold out. Season ticket holders will have a guaranteed seat in the area adjacent to the site of the competition (only 400 available).


