Since the USMS (parent organization) office considers Long Course Nationals the last meet of the season, they do not process registration applications after the entry deadline for Nationals. What this means is that it is too late to register for 1985/86, and the Newport meet technically takes place during the 1985/86 season (USMS season is from 11/1/85-10/31/86). Therein lies the problem; since you must be registered in order to swim at Newport (insurance purposes, you understand), you will have to have registered prior to Nationals in order to be eligible. Cheer up, though...The new registration year begins after October 31, in time to participate in the November Corvallis meet. A new registration form will be in the October issue of the Aqua-Master.

Deadline for submitting material for the October issue of the Aqua-Master is September 26. 
