Filling Out Entry Blank: There are no qualifying standards for this meet. Write your best time or a reasonable estimate in the space next to the event(s) you wish to enter. DO NOT ENTER WITH "NO TIME," or your entry will be rejected. You may enter six events but swim no more than three on any one day.

Eligibility: National Championships are open to USMS registered swimmers 25 years of age and older (as of August 24, 1987). If you wish to represent a club, then you and the club must be registered in the same LMSC; if any question about your affiliation, you will swim "unattached." Foreign swimmers require a travel permit with entry.

Conduct of the Meet: Meet Brochure has all details of the meet conduct. All events 200 meters & under will be pre-seeded. The 400m freestyle, the 400m fM, and the 800/1500m freestyle will be deck seeded.

Age Groups: 25-29, 30-34, etc. to 80-84, 85-89, and 90 and over. Your age is determined as of the last day of the meet (8-24-87).

Awards: National Masters Medals to first through ninth places.

Scoring: Individual Events (men/women): 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. See relay entry for relay scoring.

Fees: \$3.00 per individual event plus \$13.00 surcharge per swimmer. Fees must accompany this entry form; an entry is not considered complete until the check clears the bank; if any question about your fees, full cash payment will be required before you are permitted to swim. NOTE: Refund requests must be in writing and postmarked to the meet director no later than July 21, 1987; no refunds are given for events not swum.

Dates: August 21-24, 1987

Location: The Woodlands, Athletic Center, The Woodlands, Texas

Sanctioned by: US Masters Swimming, Inc., & the LMSC/Gulf Masters Swimming

Relay Eligibility: Each relay swimmer must be a USMS registered swimmer. Each of the four members of any relay team must be properly affiliated with the same USMS club as the other three. The club and the swimmers must all be registered in the same Local Masters Swimming Committee (LMSC). "Unattached" swimmers may not swim on relay teams. Relay entry is in addition to the individual events; however, a swimmer may swim each relay event only once (limit of 4 relay events).

Team Representative: Designate on the reverse side of this form the person who will be responsible for picking up, filling out, and returning your club's relay cards each day and claiming any awards for your club.

Relay Scoring (men/women/mixed): 20-16-14-12-10-8-6-4-2. Points from mixed relays shall count under combined team scoring only.

Awards: National Masters Medals for first through ninth to each swimmer on the relay.

Age Groups: 100+, 120+, 160+, 200+, 240+, 280+ with the cumulative ages of the relay members determining the age group of the relay. Ages are determined in whole years as of the last day of the meet (8-24-87)

Entry Beadline: Entries must be received by Tuesday, July 21, 1987: late entries will be returned to the sender. Mail Early.

Late Entries: Clubs may deck enter teams on Thursday, August 20, 1987 at the Relay Registration Desk, for a fee of \$12.00 per relay. All relay swimmers (pre-entered or deck-entered) must have entered the meet and paid the \$13.00 surcharge by July 21, 1987 If you wish to swim relays and are not entered in any individual events, you must include your name on the list below, pay the surcharge, and sign the release at the bottom of this page.

The rule is a good rule...BUT... when our friends from other associations wish to swim for time only , no medals, etc., they should be allowed to participate, long course meets are hard to come by, and we feel badly that this has happened.

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A little note regarding the longevity of records - our thanks to U S Swimming News for this little bit ...

In 1972 Mark Spitz set a new American record in the 100 yard butterfly, at 47.98. Today that time ranks him 22nd on the all time list in that event. Three more new faces would knock the former world record holder off the all time top 25 list, which now shows Nike Short in the 25th slot, with a time of 48.03.

Spitz is already off the all time list in the 200 yard butterfly. His best time of 1:49.01 was long ago eclipsed. The 25th fastest all time performer in that event is now Rick Carey with a 1:46.13.


