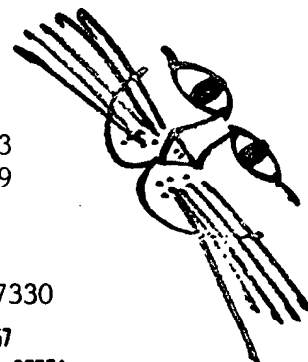
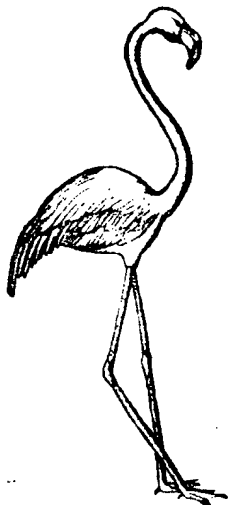

There is a special event planned at the end of Saturday's events that sounds great. The details will be available at the meet.

REDMOND - OCT. 3 & 4 - The Cascade Aquatic Masters, headed by Cindy Dunlap, is a relatively new LOG for OMS. They will be hosting our second meet of the season (also short course meters). The facility is about 8 years old and reportedly has a very nice pool. Saturday's events should be over in plenty of time for some site-seeing, hiking, etc. in the beautiful surrounding countryside. Fall is a wonderful time in Central Oregon. You won't want to miss it.

We hope to see you at these meets. It will be a good chance to warm up for the first ever Short Course Meters Regionals in Ellensburg, WA on Oct. 24 & 25.

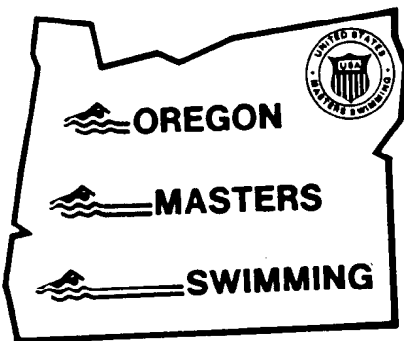
