1989 USMS NATIONAL REGISTRATION FEE INCREASE - From the USMS Pres., Tom Boak . . . "The Board of Directors of United States Masters Swimming, Inc., has unanimously voted to authorize an increase in the annual registration fee from \$5 to \$9. This has been caused by an increase in our annual liability insurance premium from \$10,000 to in excess of \$90,000, beginning with the policy year May 15, 1988. The change in fee will be effective for swimmers registering for the year beginning November 1, 1988."

Because of the above \$4 increase by the national office, the OMS, Inc. board has voted to increase the 1989 registration fee from \$10 to \$14. For more information on just where this money goes please refer to the last page of this newsletter.

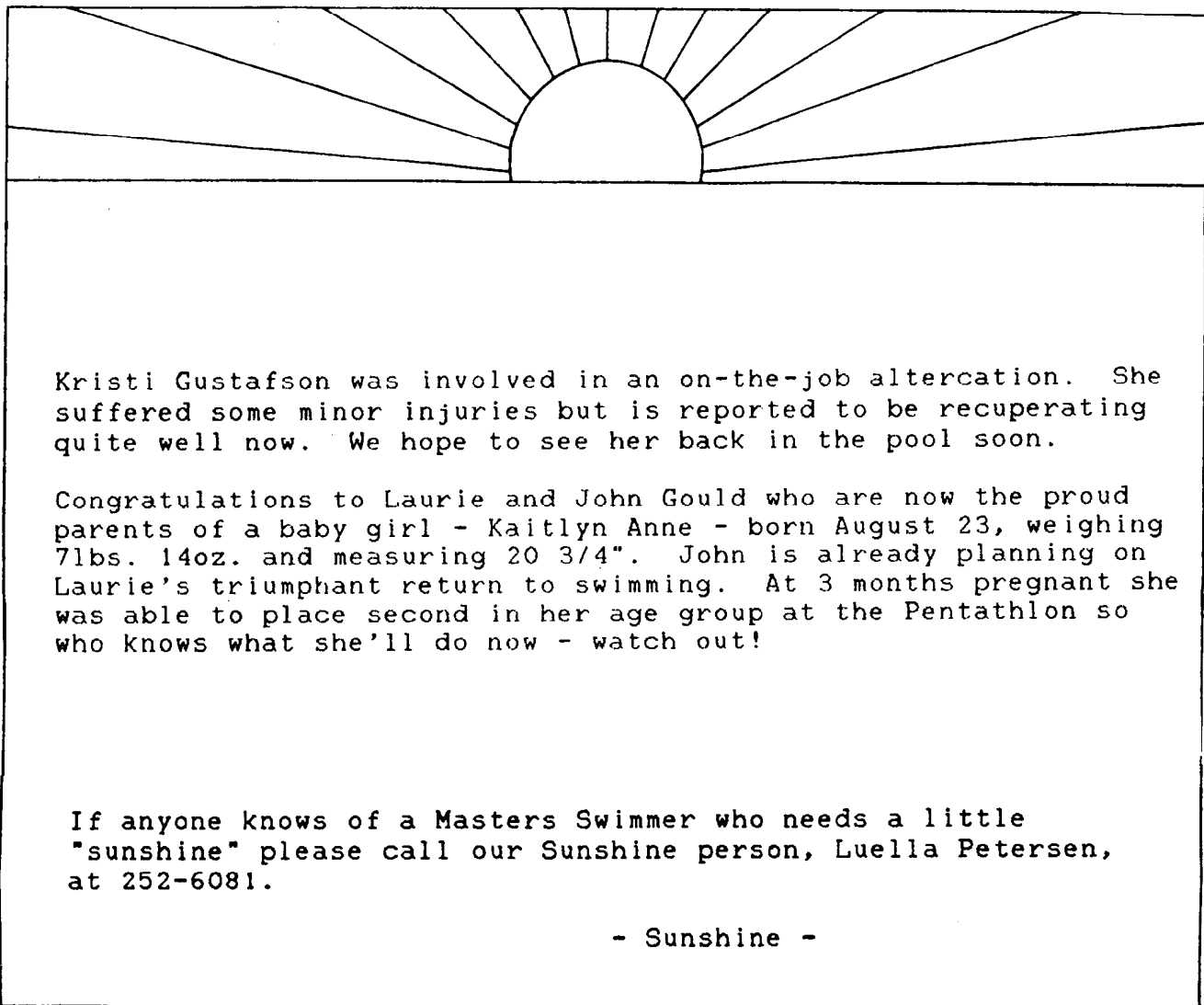

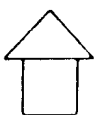

Close to 30 swimmers from OMS and MAC journeyed to Port Orchard for the Long Course Region XII Swimming Championships. Things got a little hairy on Thursday before the meet, a late afternoon call from CEO Petersen, confirmed that the bulkhead at South Kitsap, was still frozen in the up position. This of course would make it necessary to change from Long Course to Short Course.

With much wailing and gnashing of teeth everyone set about changing their psyche from one venue to the other. Late Friday those of us who were nearby received the news that the bulkhead was indeed down and the meet would be Long Course. So again the switch in concentration, et al.

Bobby Gallegos and his fine crew did a great job, water temperature was great, the facility was great, officials and timers did a fine job, and the swimmers had themselves a banner day.

OB's swimmer of the meet nominee has to be DICK BOYD from Mt Hood Masters, Dick had one of those meets any competitor dreams of having ... headline could be ...

EX DUCK "PERCOLATES" in style .. 1st - a new World Record in the 200 m Breast, breaking the old record (1983) of 2:51.18 set by Gunter Schmah of West Germany, in a great effort of 2:50.44. This also breaks the old regional record of 3:08.44 set by Don Van Rossen (Dick's collegiate coach at Oregon).

Now for icing on the cake ...

1500 free - 19:31.27 (#3 World) 1st event on Saturday
DICK BOYD 200 back - 2:48.10 (#7 World)
100 brst - 1:18.10 (#2 World), Dick now holds all the regional records in the breast, all formerly Don Van Rossen's.
200 I.M. - 2:35.85 (#2 World)

This was Dick's second meet this year with 5 or more regional records in one meet. This time he added a WORLD, fellow swimmers Boyd's feat becomes even more amazing when you realize that he swam 2600 meters in 2 days of competition all in WORLD CLASS fashion.

Performing superbly with 2 World Records and 3 Regional Records was LAVELLE STOINOFF of MAC, take a look at these numbers ...

25 countries were represented in the listings, well over 30 countries in the world now have Masters swimming programs. Leading the way for Oregon were ;

HERB EISENSCHMIDT (St Helens) with 10 placings, capped off with # 1's in the 50, 100 and 400 free(41.59, 1:42.52, 8:09.11) plus the 200 back, the 50 fly and 200 IM (4:04.79, 56.27, 4:22.70) # 2's came in the 100 back and 50 breast (1:52.79, 56.32) a # 3 in the 50 back (49.58) and a # 5 in the 200 free at 4:00.41.

Herb was also picked # 1 swimmer for his age group in the U.S.

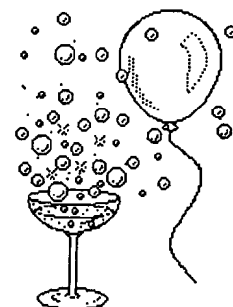

Summary of OMS Membership for 1988

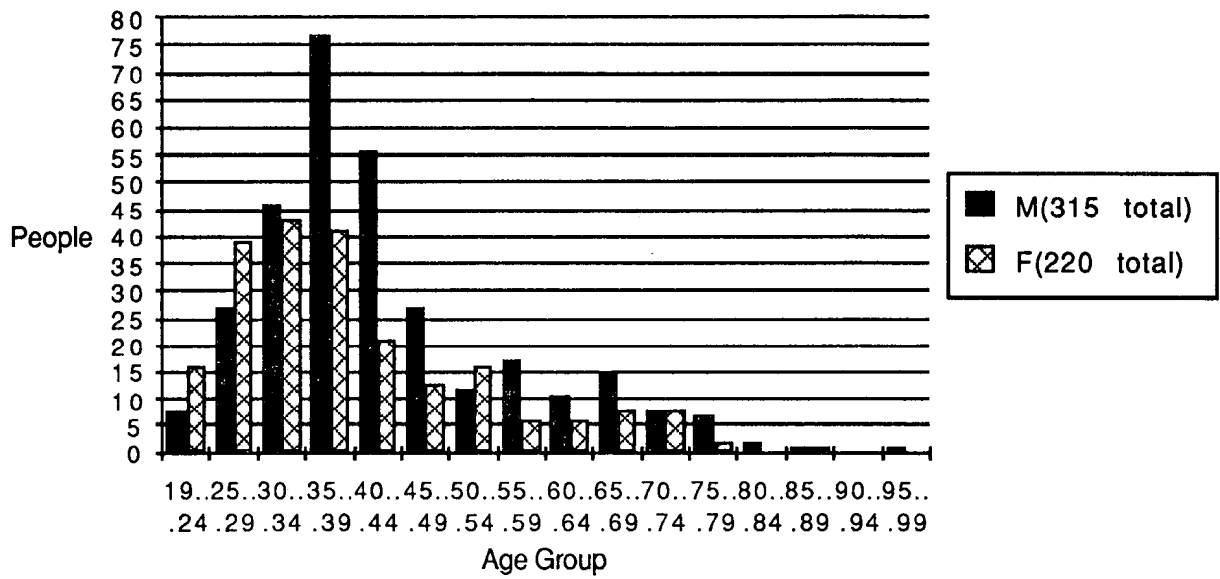
Our two year term in the office of Registration Chairman/Database Manager is coming to an end. In this newsletter the new registration form should be available, with the address of the new Registration Chairman/Database Manager.

In retrospect, we would like to present the following summaries of OMS membership in graphic form. The first is a graph of 1988 membership. The total membership is 535 (Male 315, Female 220). This is almost identical to 1987 (538), but is distributed a little bit differently. (The second graph is of 1987 membership.) As the graphs and numbers show, we have fewer women (approximately 10%) and more men. The 30-34 and 40-44 age groups appear to have "lost" the most women.

On the men's side, the 45-49 age group appears to have grown more than "aging up" can account for, along with the 65-69 age group. The dominant age group is still by far the 35-39. Although there are 75+ in this group, the most who have participated in any one OMS swim meet is 17 in the Pentathlon. Where or when do the other 60 compete ?

Bruce would also like to take this opportunity to make one last plug for our computer system. In my REAL job (microelectronics design with exotic materials) I use a variety of computers, from IBM mainframes to IBM PC's, Apollo's to VAXes to Daisys, and also Apple Macintoshes. For this job, we use a Macintosh because of one major reason: The software (including the operating system) on Macintoshes is superior to all those other systems. That is why the obsolete MS-DOS/IBM PC CLONE systems (IBM doesn't even make "PCs" anymore!!) are desperately trying to imitate the Macintosh. Our Mac has been a friendly and reliable system throughout. If you are considering a personal computer, a Mac is the one to get. If it is a little more expensive than your average clone, it should be!! It's better.

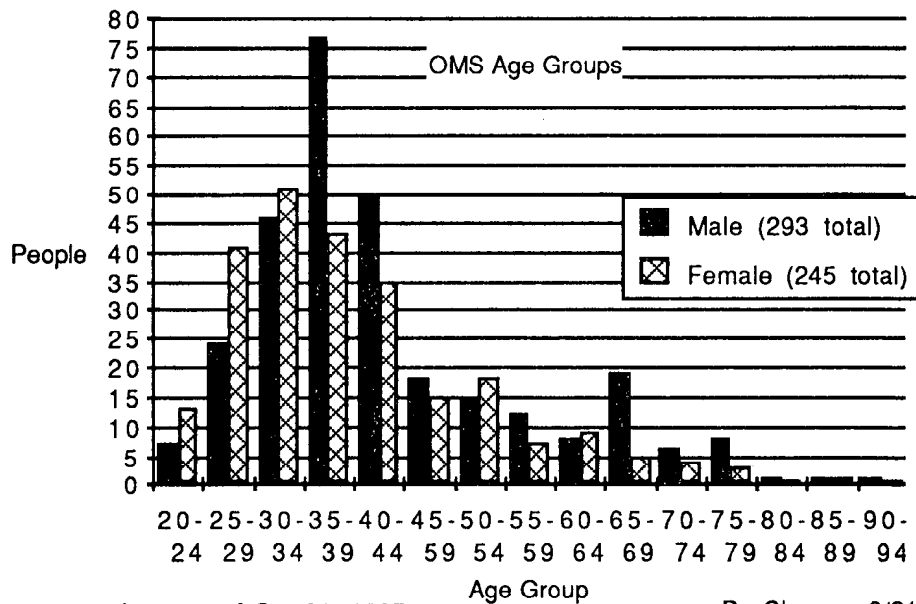
OMS Age Groups
