

MONTANA MASTERS SHORT COURSE CHAMPIONSHIPS AND INVITATIONAL SWIM MEET

FRIDAY, MAY 26 and SATURDAY, MAY 27, 1989 MISSOULA, MONTANA

 $\overline{\text{Location}}$ University of Montana Grizzly Pool on the UM campus. Take the Van Buren exit off I-90, proceed west on Broadway for two blocks, turn left onto Madison Street south over the Clark Fork river and follow the signs to the UM campus. The pool is adjacent to the south end of the field house.

DATE AND TIME Friday May 26, warm-up 7:30 pm. swim 8:00 pm.
Saturday May 27, warm up 8:00 am, swim 9:00 am
The meet should be finished by early afternoon Saturday.

SANCTIONS AND RULES The meet is sponsored by Montana Masters, and held under the sanction of United States Masters Swimming (sanction #31901). All entrants must be currently registered USMS swimmers.* The meet is open to all swimmers 19 and older. Competitors 19-24 years of age may jeopardize their amateur standing under FINA rule GR-1 by competing at a master's meet. Age group shall be governed by age on the first day of the meet.

Meet officials and electronic timing will be provided by Montana Masters. All events are timed finals. During warm up, no diving from blocks, except in lanes 1 and 7, or hand paddles will be allowed.

ENTRIES and AWARDS An entry fee of \$10.00 is payable at the time of entry. Entries must be postmarked no later than May 22, 1989. Make entry fee payable to Montana Masters and send with entry to Jeanne Ensign, Box 7338, Missoula, MY 59807.

Each swimmer may compete in a total of four individual events plus relays per day. Enter relays during the warmups. All 5 year USMS age groups will be recognized. Entries will be seeded by sex without respect to age, allowing swimmers of similar skill to compete. Entrants shall submit their seed times based on the fastest yard or converted meter times within the previous year. Awards will be given for all age groups in each individual event and relays.

 $\underline{\text{FOOD}}$ AND HOUSING Housing is available with local swimmers. Contact the meet director in advance for more information about housing. Computerized Team Scoring

Last year at Corvallis, I helped a little with the team scoring. It was a tedious and frustrating process, especially when you found out near the end of the meet that a mistake had been made on event number two! When Chehalem Masters (my home team) offered to host the Association meet this year, I promised the meet director that we would have the team results completed within five minutes of the posting of the last event, no matter what.

My approach was to use a spreadsheet program. Each event would have its own spreadsheet with all age/sex groups listed. The scorer would type in the team name for 1st through 6th place, in each of 30 age/sex groups. This sounds like a lot of typing, but most "places" are blank. Only the Male 35-39 group consistently has all 6 places awarded. The use of an assistant (Judy McCurdy) was very valuable here. She read the data from the results sheets while I typed.

After the data had been entered and double checked, I executed a "macro" (a pre-written subroutine) that accumulated all the points for each team and placed the totals for that event in the "master" spreadsheet called "Team Scores." "Team Scores" automatically summed up the totals for each team as the event subtotals were calculated.

If an error occurred, say a swimmers team was listed incorrectly, I only had to bring up the events she swam in, correct her team, re-score that event, and bingo! A new Team Score sheet popped out!

The acid test came as the last event finished.

The meet director announced: "Take your showers and dress, and results will be available before you get out of the locker room!"

The last event is a relay, which doesn't have many entries, but counts double points. Judy read the teams, I typed them in and the final sums appeared. But to print the results of 26 teams in 22 events takes a while on a line printer! So we wrote out the final placements for the awards ceremony and posted all the results shortly after.

It was a strange way to watch a meet: typing in results in a backroom. I felt like a hermit emerging when I came out to watch, eat, or swim in the warmup pool. I could actually observe some team strategies develop as the weekend went on. I also saw some tactical mistakes. After the meet, the data could be manipulated into a third dimension: points by event as a percentage of the total points possible in an event. This way the "underpopulated" events should stand out.

The sequence is not too surprising: 200 BF, 400 IM, 100 BF, 200 IM, 200 BR. Those are the LEAST popular events in least-to-most order. So, Team Captains, if you need an "easy" score, stack these events!!

PS. The honorary title "First Gentlemen" is the appropriate address for the husband of the President of OMS. The duties of the office include answering the phone a lot, running errands, and miscellaneous computer tasks.


