LOCATION: Mt. Hood Community College, 26000 SE Stark Street, Gresham, Oregon

SANCTION: This event is held under the sanction of United States Masters Swimming, Inc.

FILLING OUT THE OTHER SIDE OF THIS FORM: There are no qualifying standards for this meet. Please enter your best time or a reasonable estimated time in the space next to the event(s) you wish to swim and in the correct sex classification. DO NOT ENTER "no time" opposite an event because it will not be considered as entered. EVENT LIMIT: You may enter six (6) events and swim no more than six, no more than three(3) events on any single day of the meet; this does not include relays. If you enter more than three events on one day, the last event will be ignored.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must possess a current association registration as specified in the rules of Masters swimming. If a swimmer wishes to affiliate with a Masters swim team, then the swimmer and the masters swim team must both be registered in the same association. If there are any questions about a swimmer's affiliation, he/she will be entered in this meet as "unattached."

CONDUCT OF THE MEET - SEEDING: Seeding will be by age group and by sex, with fastest swimmers first in each age group. The meet director reserves the right to place slower swimmers in empty lanes in another age group after at least one full heat has been seeded in each age group. All events (except the 1500 m. freestyle) will be pre-seeded; consult your program (in your registration packet) for the heat and lane assigned to you.

SCRATCHES: Swimmers who fail to report to the proper lane in the correct heat of their entered event ordinarily will not be permitted to swim that event at another time and will be considered as scratched from that event. Deck entries will not be accepted.

AGE GROUPS: Age groups are 25-29, 30-34, etc. to 80-84, 85-89, and 90+. All events are swum youngest to oldest. AWARDS: National Masters Medals will be awarded for first place through ninth place in all events, in each age group. Awards may be claimed twenty minutes after results are posted. TEAM SCORING: 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1.

FEES: \$3.00 per individual event plus a \$10.00 surcharge per swimmer. Fees must be included with this entry form. An entry will not be considered complete until the check clears the bank. If there is any question about an entrant's check, full cash payment will be required before being allowed to swim. Note: Requests for refunds for overpayment, or of entries previously made, will only be accepted if made in writing to the sponsoring committee and received prior to July 21, 1982.

GET-TOGETHER DINNER: Saturday, August 28, 1982, at the Sheraton Inn, Portland Airport. A night to remember, limited to the first 700 responses, will begin at 7:30 p.m., preceded by a social hour. Remit price of \$12.50 per person with entry.

You must enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard which will be returned to you as proof of your entry receipt. DO NOT SEND BY REGISTERED OR CERTIFIED MAIL. Foreign entries are due postmarked no later than July 2, 1982, send travel permit.
